Pastoral Letter

Dear Friends,

On Sunday, November 9, we will recognise Remembrance Sunday in worship. The service will pause at 10:30 for any who wish to leave our service to go and attend the town service which will take place at the cross. I will attend the start of our service and then leave to help lead the town service.

At the end of the month, on 30 November, the season of Advent begins. This year we will be exploring the Methodist Church theme for the year which is "Gifted." Here is what they have to say about it:

"Gifted" is a message of good news to a weary world...you are a gift, made with love.

Together, all districts, circuits, local churches and fellowships of the Methodist

Church are invited to remind people of their inherent worth and beauty – not because
of what they've done, or what they can give – but because of who they are.

"Gifted" is for everyone in our churches and beyond: both believers rejoicing at God's gift of Jesus, and those who might find the season more wearying than wonderful.

"Gifted" reaches out to people longing for transformation but feeling stuck. For those searching for something more, something real – but unsure where to look.
