Help wanted

We are running short of people willing to operate the sound desk in the Church on Sundays on a rota basis. Please could you help? If so please could you let Gareth/Yvette know – full training will be given.

Tub2Pub recycling of plastic sweet and biscuit containers

Make sure your tubs don't go to waste! Bring your clean, empty plastic confectionery and biscuit tubs to the church on Tuesday or Friday mornings or on Sundays between 1 January and 13 February 2026 to be recycled.

Many kerbside recycling collections will not accept these polypropylene tubs, so Tub2Pub is a recycling solution that stops them ending up in landfill.

Tub2Pub collected over 240,000 tubs last year, weighing in at a record-breaking 27,990 kg of plastic - more than all previous years combined.

Since Greene King launched Tub2Pub they've helped to divert over 470,000 tubs from landfill and, with the proceeds from recycling the tubs going to their national charity partner, Macmillan Cancer Support, over £34,000 has been raised to help fund vital support for people living with cancer.
